GARDEN DESCRIPTIONS

1. ♿ **William Woods - Derby Villa 32 Nursery Lane Wilmslow SK9 5JQ** A well established garden, thought to be part of one of the original nurseries of Nursery Lane when the house was built in 1869. Small front garden with roaming perennials and wild flowers. Recently built Victorian style greenhouse and terrace with pots and planters leading on to a second greenhouse and growing area with many medicinal and culinary herbs and home for Blackbrook Herb Gardens. Secluded lawn at the end of the garden surrounded by shrubs, fruit bushes and herbaceous perennials. **Selection of donated plants for sale. Outside WC.**
2. **David & Caroline Melliar-Smith - 68 South Oak Lane Wilmslow SK9 6AT** Attractive small hedged cottage garden shows the owners' passion for plants. Year round colour, scent and interest. Enjoy tranquillity and peace on this plant-packed journey. **This garden opens for the NGS.**
3. ♿ **Ann & Brian Grieve - 17 Newlands Drive Wilmslow SK9 6BT** A compact Garden with herbaceous borders, wildlife pond and greenhouse with Streptocarpus plants, some of them for sale. There is a small aviary with canaries.
4. ♿ **Doug & Anne Macdonald - 14, Mayfield Grove off New Street, off Moor Lane Wilmslow SK9 6BU** Third of an acre garden; 3 wildlife ponds, 1 island bed, raised vegetable beds, herbaceous borders, mature trees and shrubs. Children must be supervised. **Tea & Home Made Cakes. Parking at Riflemans Arms.**
5. ♿ **Richard & Bethan Weston - 36 The Circuit Wilmslow SK9 6DB** The garden at 36 The Circuit is home to The Wilmslow and Lindow Light Railway, a 16mm, narrow gauge, live steam model railway. Steam trains will be running throughout the day and **refreshments including ice lollies for the small and big kids alike will be available!**
6. ♿ **Eileen Clayton - 1 South Close Wilmslow SK9 5JZ** A garden specifically designed to be easy to maintain with a large variety of climbing plants including over 30 varieties of clematis, 2 herbaceous borders, raised beds and a wildlife pond. Productive fruit and vegetable areas and a working greenhouse. Redesigned front garden with a collection of ornamental grasses. **Plants for Sale.**
7. ♿ **John & Meriel Currie - 23 Green Villa Park Wilmslow SK9 6EJ** An interesting 1/3rd acre garden divided by a stream with a bog garden border, a goldfish pond, herbaceous, Hosta and vegetable beds. **Plants for Sale.**
8. ♿ **Fiona MacDonald - 18 Summerfield Place Wilmslow SK9 1NE** A secluded corner garden partially redesigned in 2014 to enable a shared living space between the house and garden. Featuring a raised flower bed planted with perennials to provide summer colour. Clever use of paving and fencing materials provide interest and continuity in the original garden area. **Tea and Homemade Cakes available here.**
9. ♿ **David & Carys Cash - 61 Hawthorn Lane Wilmslow SK9 5DQ** Three levels of garden united by a curved lawn which extends above a stone patio. A number of mature trees (inc. a tulip tree). Well stocked herbaceous borders, fernery, hosta collection, raised vegetable beds and greenhouse. **Tea & homemade cakes here. Plants for Sale.**
10. ♿ **Jonathan & Anna Meadmore - Orchard House 104 Lacey Green Wilmslow SK9 4BN** When we arrived in 2011, the front garden had been landscaped. The back garden consisted of moss, laurel hedge and wire netting, and the orchard was a wilderness. After much clearing and new planting, we now have a border, beds for shrubs and a stone feature from Honister Quarry. Beside the old trees in the orchard are beehives, a fruit cage, potato patches and a raised vegetable bed. **Please park along the road or on Twinnies Road.**
11. ♿ **Belinda Geddes & David Pritchard - Parkfield Woodend Lane Styal SK9 4HF** Large mature garden blending traditional and modern design influences. There are formal areas and courtyards, two ponds and a range of specimen trees and shrubs. Curving paths lead to a gazebo through herbaceous planting via a circular stone terrace with glacial boulders and a large wooden sculpture constructed from old railway sleepers. **Parking: follow drive past house into farmyard then into field on left.**
12. **John & Christine Little - 15 Deanway off Bridgefield Avenue off Manchester Road SK9 2JT** A garden created from scratch. It is now a haven, including ponds and patios and is intensely planted with shrubs, perennials and small specimen trees. Numerous clematis and scented roses. **Please park in Bridgefield Avenue.**
13. **Barry & Melanie Davy - Brook Cottage Church Road Handforth SK9 3LT** A plantaholics garden; divided in to 3 distinct areas: Woodland area, with over 30 types of fern and other shade loving plants; herbaceous borders with a wide variety of plants including ornamental grasses; container garden with a huge variety of hostas. Brooke Cottage has featured in several magazines over the last three years including the RHS "The Garden" in August 2016. Part of the garden has been remodelled since the last opening (NGS 2015).
14. ♿ **Steven & Jill Kimber - Well House Dean Row Road Wilmslow SK9 2BU** In this maturing 3 acre garden wander through the woodland, search for wild orchids in the meadow; follow the herbaceous border to the "boule court" and wild flower area, planted with native species. **This garden opens for the NGS. Tea & Home Made Cakes. Park at Unicorn, using spaces behind Barfield Rd.**
15. **Gerry Lemon & Angela Ferguson - Bollin House Hollies Lane Wilmslow SK9 2BW** There are two parts to this garden, formal and a wild flower meadow. The garden contains richly planted, herbaceous borders, an orchard, wild flower garden and vegetable plot. In the meadow are cornfield annuals and perennial wild flowers; easily accessible with mown paths. **This garden opens for the NGS.**
16. ♿ **Donald & Carolyn Henderson - Orchard Main 31 Trafford Road Alderley Edge SK9 7HL** A delightful village garden with a formal front garden including roses annuals and flowering shrubs. At the back there is a glorious herbaceous border, summer house, many shrubs, a small vegetable garden, patio courtyard area with pots plus a working greenhouse. **Tea and homemade cakes served here. Park at the Festival Hall or Mottram Road.**
17. **Colin & Carol Summersgill - 7 Heyes Lane Alderley Edge SK9 7LA** A small town garden skilfully terraced with contemporary features for outdoor living, enhanced with a beautifully coordinated modern planting scheme. **Park at Festival Hall.**
18. ♿ **Peter Woolam - Hough Garden Hough Lane Alderley Edge SK9 7JE** A half acre organic ornamental kitchen garden; over 200 edible varieties. Many wood and willow structures made by Peter. **This garden has been featured in several national garden magazines.**
19. ♿ **Jenny Morris - Kennerley House Entrance on Foden Lane Mobberley WA16 7BA** A three acre mature garden including natural ponds, stream, woodland, herbaceous borders, fruit and vegetable garden, a collection of planted chimney pots and old working water pump. **Tea and homemade cakes, plants for sale, outside loo. Partial Disabled Access. Parking on the Drive.**
