WILMSLOW WELLS FOR AFRICA GARDENS DAY, 24th JUNE 2023, 10.30am - 4.30pm

- 1. Janette and Paul Hopkin Longcroft, Oak Road, Mottram St Andrew, SK10 4RA (west side of Oak Road 500m south of village centre) This country garden has long views to the hills. It has formal and informal spaces made up of mixed borders, hard landscaping, artworks, wild parts including a small woodland, pools and a vegetable garden. Gravel and grass paths make wheelchairs hard work but there are no steps. Park on the road opposite the house.
- 2. EPeter Woollam Hough Garden, Hough Lane, Alderley Edge, SK9 7JE A half-acre organic ornamental kitchen garden with over 200 edible varieties. Many wood and willow structures made by Peter. This garden has been featured in national garden magazines
- 3. Jo and David Mottershead Cheriton, 34 Congleton Road, Alderley Edge, SK9 7AB SW-facing with long views, this1-acre garden is split into cottage, oriental and white birch areas. Mature, including herbaceous plants and young specimen trees. Significant and exciting new changes made in all gardens. Tea and cakes served here.
- 4. Chorley Hall Lane Allotments Chorley Hall Iane, Alderley Edge. Chorley Hall Lane Allotment Association welcomes you on behalf of all our allotmenteers to our gardening haven where we grow a wide range of fruit, vegetables and flowers. We were recognised with a 2022 RHS and North West in bloom "It's your neighbourhood" Award at Level 5 Outstanding. Parking available on site (access from Chorley Hall Lane adjacent to the railway bridge) with an alternative pedestrian entrance from the park.
- 5. Ann and Nick Vaughan 9 Strawberry Lane, Wilmslow SK9 6AQ A mature garden with mixed herbaceous borders, 2 rose arches, fruit trees, raised salad and vegetable beds, a greenhouse and a small wildlife pond. The planting is being developed to encourage pollinators and so that we have something in flower each month of the year. Plants for Sale.
- 6. Eileen Clayton 1 South Close, Wilmslow, SK9 5JZ This garden has many climbing plants including 40+ clematis varieties, two herbaceous borders, raised beds, a wildlife pond and a productive fruit area. The re-modelled front garden features two curved trellises planted with clematis and new beds with unusual plants. Plants for sale.
- 7. Maxine Drabble 1A Broad Walk, Wilmslow, SK9 5PJ A delightful garden in an awkwardly shaped plot originally designed for shade. The back garden is in a contemporary urban style while the front is more traditional. Planted with climbing roses, clematis and herbaceous perennials. Bacon rolls until 1.30 and cream teas all day.
- 8. Carys and David Cash, 61 Hawthorn Lane, Wilmslow, SK9 5DQ The three levels of this garden are united by a flowing lawn flanked by well stocked herbaceous borders, with a tulip tree, fernery, modern greenhouse with several tomato and cucumber varieties, raised vegetable beds and a recently developed area with shade loving plants. Tea and homemade cakes. Plants for sale.
- 9. Frances and Peter Trainer, 50A, Hawthorn Lane, Wilmslow, SK9 5DQ With views out to The Carrs through mature woodland, there are many different areas to this sloping garden which has a variety of shrubs (including several maple varieties), roses, perennials and bulbs. There are also two ponds with associated bog plants.
- 10. Christine and Roger Goddard The Spinney, 35a Bollin Hill, Wilmslow, SK9 4AN This south facing garden has a circular lawn as its central feature which is approached via gently stepped paths flanked by well planted borders with water features. Beyond, walkways meander through the wooded backdrop with plantings of camellia and rhododendron species. Tea and homemade cakes served here.
- 11. Liz and Rick Maddock, 7 Kingsley Avenue, Wilmslow, SK9 4EN A medium sized garden mainly perennials and shrubs, some of which are decorative or unusual, with a rock garden at the front. A large number of pots, mainly containing cacti and succulents, also many Sempervivums and decorative pots with attractive displays of hardy succulents and summer plants.
- 12. Jino and Sathi Sukumar Woodend House, Woodend, Styal, SK9 4HF Come and visit our garden of pure delight. The large pond (children must be supervised) filled with water plants is the heart of the garden surrounded by borders brimming with enchanting hostas. Enjoy a short woodland walk to admire the mature trees and nature's choir. With an adjoining paddock to complete, our 2-acre garden is a true retreat. Parking available as directed at garden entrance.
- 13. Barry and Melanie Davy Brooke Cottage, Church Road, Handforth, SK9 3LT A plantaholics paradise, this garden has three distinct zones: a woodland area with over 30 types of fern plus other shade loving plants; herbaceous borders (also featuring ornamental grasses); and a container garden with 40+ hosta varieties, interspersed large leaved plants to provide shade. This garden opens for the NGS and has featured in the RHS "The Garden" magazine.
- 14. Angela Harding 28 Handforth Road, Handforth, SK9 2LU A lovely garden with views to Kinder Scout and Lyme Park. There are herbaceous borders, shrubs and a working greenhouse. Park opposite in Oaklands Close.
- 15. Angela Ferguson and Gerry Lemon Bollin House, Hollies Lane, Wilmslow, SK9 2BW A garden with great views, a wild flower meadow and beautiful, wide, perennial filled borders as well as a formal area with parterres and water feature. Refreshments here.
- 16. Peter and Tress Attwell 31 Adlington Road, Wilmslow, SK9 2BJ A one-acre garden comprising herbaceous borders and a pond around the lawn with a rose and clematis covered pergola leading to a vegetable plot with a greenhouse and small orchard. Possible parking in Overhill Road (accessible from Wilmslow Park Road) with consideration to the residents
